POSITION

Welcoming

GOAL OF POSITION

To welcome people to our Church service and to positively contribute to their worship experience at our Church.

KEY FUNCTIONS

The welcomer will:

- Greet people arriving for the worship service
- Distribute weekly notice sheet and any other handouts
- Invite visitors to sign the Visitors' Book
- Two minutes prior to the commencement of the service, ring the church bell (12 times approximately one second apart)
- At the commencement of the service, close the door between the entry and the church. It is preferable for latecomers to not enter the church during prayer.
- Prior to the commencement of the service, arrange with another member of the congregation to assist with collection of the freewill offering
- During the service, assist with the collection of the freewill offering;
- After the service assist visitors and newcomers to meet the Minister and members of the congregation.

SUGGESTIONS FOR AS AND WHEN REQUIRED

- Arrange assistance for entry into the church of physically impaired people
- Encourage people to be inside the church ready for the commencement of the service
- After the service, see that visitors and newcomers are not left alone

TIME REQUIREMENTS The welcomer is requested to be at the Church and ready to commence welcoming at least twenty minutes prior to the commencement of the service.

The welcomer is to remain at the entry until the commencement of the first hymn of the service.

SPECIAL SKILLS

- Warm and friendly
- Knowing members of the congregation
